ThunderCloud Xchange allows teams to upload and share specific files with other teams.

# New Features

# New page grid implemented in the "Shared To My Team" and "My Team Upload" tabs:

- 1. Sorts most recently uploaded and shared files at the top by default
- 2. Allows users to sort files by Game Date, Home Team, Away Team and Shooter
- 3. Adds page navigation controls at the bottom of the page

# **Features**

- 1. Upload Manager Upload and share files based on league, conference and team association
- 2. Shared To My Team View files and download files shared to the team with which they are associated
- 3. My Team Uploads View, download, delete, and changes sharing properties of files they have uploaded
- 4. User Preferences Change the default download directory as well as Download Media Preferences (transcode)

# • Java

- ThunderCloud Xchange requires Java to run.
- As listed above XOS requires Java 7 update 15 or Java 6 update 41 as the minimum supported revision
- Firefox
  - Due to issues identified XOS requires Java 7 update 15 or Java 6 update 41 as the minimum supported revision

# Java Support on Macs

- Java 7 (latest) on a Mac requires an Intel-based Mac running Mac OS X 10.7.3 (Lion) or later.
- If Java 7 is installed on a Mac OS 10.7.3 system, a 64-bit browser is required (e.g. Safari or Firefox)
  Chrome cannot be used on a Mac since it is currently 32-bit only.
- Users with Mac OS X version 10.6 and below can go to Software Update under the Apple menu to check for Java updates.
- Users with Mac OS X version 10.7.x or later must go to Java.com to install latest version of Java
